Through the KTR program, we provide technical assistance, education, and market access to increase recycling in rural and underserved communities across the state of Texas. The fellow will conduct research to identify community interest in creating new recycling programs, as well as funding and infrastructure needs for both new and existing recycling programs in rural and underserved communities. The fellow will expand the capacity of the Programs team, as well as the reach of the Keep Texas Recycling program, by identifying communities that want to recycle and determining what they need to start their recycling programs. KTB will use this information to strategize and solicit future partner investments to support the implementation of new recycling programs or the improvement of existing ones.
